NCAR Scientists Appointed to University Posts

Boulder, Colo.---Two staff scientists at the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) here have recently been appointed to affiliate professorships at the University of Michigan and the University of Missouri.

Dr. Burton G. Schuster has been appointed affiliate professor of physics at the University of Missouri at Rolla. He will serve primarily as a consultant on atmospheric physics, and as a Ph.D. candidate research advisor.

Dr. Schuster, a native of Rochester, New York, received his Ph.D. in physics from New Mexico State University in 1967. Before joining NCAR in 1966, he was a research and teaching assistant at New Mexico State University. He has also been a staff member of the Los Alamos Scientific Laboratory, and has worked at White Sands Missile Range and the Wollensak Optical Company. From 1955 to 1957, he served in the U. S. Army Chemical Corps. Dr. Schuster is a member of the American Physical Society and of Sigma Xi.

Dr. Warren M. Washington has been appointed affiliate adjunct associate professor of meteorology and oceanography at the University of Michigan, where he will work with students and faculty members in the field of dynamic meteorology.

Dr. Washington was born in Portland, Oregon, and received his Ph.D. from the Pennsylvania State University in 1964. Before joining the NCAR staff, he held research assistantships at the Pennsylvania State University and Oregon State Research Institute. He has also worked as a research mathematician at Stanford Research Institute in Menlo Park, California. Dr. Washington is a member of Sigma Xi and the American Meteorological Society.

Both appointments were made under the NCAR affiliate professorship program, established in 1965. This program permits NCAR staff scientists to establish formal ties with universities in order to spend part of their time teaching or participating in other academic activities on the campus. These two appointments bring the total number of NCAR affiliate professorships now in force to twelve.
