

Here is the National Hail Research Experiment report for Monday, June 3.

No hailstorm or thunderstorm activity developed over the experimental area during the weekend, and this situation seems to be continuing today. As of 4:15 this afternoon, the radar at Grover showed no signs of th^understorm buildup, and only a few cumulus clouds and very light showers seem to be developing around the experimental area along the Colorado-Nebraska state line (~~northwest of Sterling~~) (~~north of Fort Morgan~~) (~~south of Kimball~~) (Southwest of Sidney).
