

Here is the National Hail Research Experiment report for Thursday, July 25.

Owing to some telephone communication difficulties, yesterday's report was incomplete and not entirely accurate. Tuesday was not a hail day, ~~and~~ Yesterday was a hail day, but no cloud seeding was done. The hail day was declared when a storm moved across the <sup>experimental</sup> area, generally following a line from Kimball to Sterling. Three-quarter<sup>^</sup> inch hail was reported near Sterling Reservoir.

At 4:00 p.m. today, the radar showed no signs of hailstorm development anywhere in the vicinity. ~~We have had 23 hail days so far this year~~
