

Here is the National Hail Research Experiment report for Thursday, July 8.

Wednesday was an active day for the hail researchers. A hail day was declared at 2:23 p.m. when a big hailstorm threatened the experimental area. This storm, and another one that developed over the area at about 5:30, were seeded with silver iodide. At the peak of the cloud-seeding activity, all five seeding aircraft were up. The hailstorm activity died down and the seeding aircraft returned to their base at Greeley at about 6:30.

At 4:00 this afternoon, there were rain showers all around the area, but the radar showed no signs of hailstorm development.
