New Art Exhibit at NCAR

Boulder, Colorado---Drawings and paintings by David Fox of Boulder will constitute the second one-person show to be exhibited by the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) under its 1975 community art exhibit program.

Fox's work will be shown through March 31 in the second-floor exhibit area of the NCAR Mesa Laboratory, which is located at the west end of Table Mesa Drive in southwest Boulder.

A graduate of the University of Colorado, Fox is completing his graduate work in the CU Fine Arts Department. He began working in painting and drawing media while attending the University of Southwestern Louisiana, and began working in sculpture as well when he moved to Colorado in 1972. His current interests include film animation as well as latex and ceramic sculpture. He expects to show some of his work in Denver beginning in May.

Other artists whose work will be shown at NCAR over the next four months are Howard Crosslen, Sybil Moschetti, and Sibylla Mathews, all of Boulder. Their work was selected in January by an NCAR jury.
