### New Art Exhibit at NCAR

Boulder, Colorado---Watercolors by Sybil Moschetti of Boulder will constitute the third one-person show to be exhibited by the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) under its 1975 community art exhibit program.

Moschetti's work will be shown through April 30 in the second-floor exhibit area of the NCAR Mesa Laboratory, which is located at the west end of Table Mesa Drive in Boulder.

A native of Colorado, Moschetti is a graduate of the University of Colorado. She describes herself as largely self-taught, although she has participated in several workshops and classes.

Moschetti has exhibited widely throughout Colorado, and has won a number of awards for her watercolors. Her most recent honor is an acceptance to the American Watercolor Society annual show in New York this month.

The work of two other Boulder artists, Howard Crosslen and Sibylla Mathews, will be shown at NCAR in May and June.
