KELLETT TO EXHIBIT PAINTINGS AT NCAR

Boulder, CO---Nancy Kellett will exhibit her paintings at the National Center for Atmospheric Research (NCAR) during the month of August. The NCAR Gallery, on the second floor of the Mesa Laboratory at the west end of Table Mesa Drive, is open to visitors from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays.

Kellett's one-man show will be a combination of media: acrylic paint, graphite, charcoal and oil pastel. "Whether an abstract landscape, plant form or animal, my images are linked by lines that define the connectedness between all life forms," she says. "They are energy networks of birth, growth, and being." Her earlier work is more realistic, representing the feelings, textures, sounds and sights of the world in which we live.

The artist received her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the University of Colorado and a Master's degree from Rosary College, Graduate School of Fine Art, at the Villa Schifanoia in Florence, Italy. She currently teaches drawing, design, crafts and sculpture at Thornton High School in Thornton, Colorado. Her works have been exhibited in Florence, Italy, Boulder and Denver.
