NCAR's Research Aviation Facility Sponsors Workshop on Management and Analysis of Data Relating to Kuwait Oil Fires

More than 30 researchers from Canada, the Federal Republic of Germany, the Netherlands, Saudi Arabia and the United States, including representatives from the Atmospheric Environment Service, the Defense Nuclear Agency, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Bahrain's Environmental Protection Committee (EPC), NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory, King Fahd University of Petroleum and Minerals (KFUPM), Saudi Arabia's Meteorological and Environmental Protection Agency (MEPA), NOAA, and the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) met at NCAR on July 22–24.

At the workshop, termed the "Management and Analysis of Data Relating to the Kuwait Oil Fires," participants discussed the requirements for an archive of all data sets gathered during atmospheric studies of the Gulf war fires. The workshop was organized as follows:
